Terms and Conditions

The Shuttle is operated on behalf of the Chobham Community Interest Company (CCIC) by Woking Community Transport Services and Surrey County Council, under Section 19 of the Transport Act 1985. When you buy your tickets at the Post Office for the first time, you must register as a member of the CCIC. Any surplus that the CCIC might generate from the Shuttle service will be used to further improve community transport, or to benefit the community of Chobham in other ways. As the Post Office will receive

a small commission for selling tickets, you are also supporting this valuable village service. Tickets must be purchased in advance and are valid for one journey on the Chobham Shuttle: they cannot be used on any other service. No concessionary fares are currently available on the Chobham Shuttle but children under five years may travel free. A ticket implies no guarantee of the timing or availability of the Chobham Shuttle service and is valid up to six months from its date of purchase.
