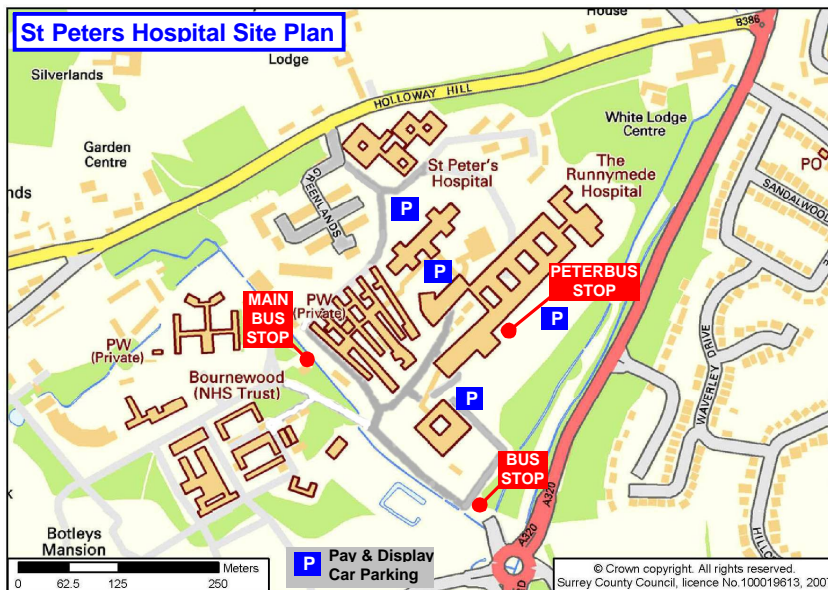
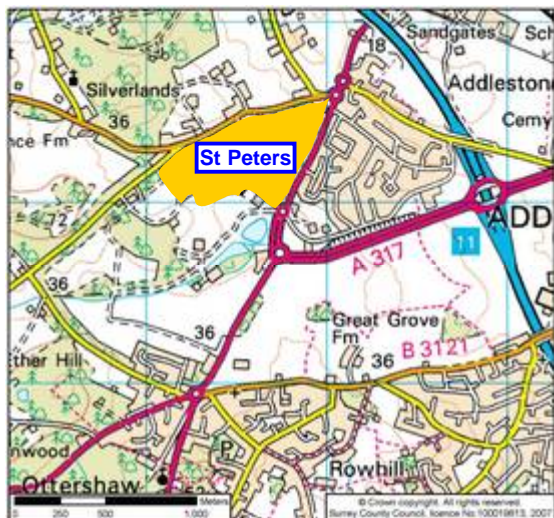


How to get to: St Peters Hospital – from Chobham

- By car (about 4 miles)

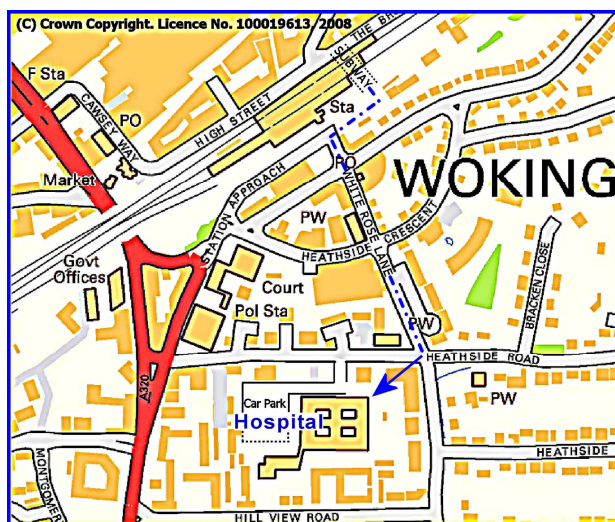


Car Parking **Pay & Display** (Vehicles displaying blue disabled badge may park free of charge in designated spaces).

How to get to: Woking Community Hospital – from Chobham

Woking Community Hospital, Heathside Road,
 Woking, GU22 7HS Tel: 01483 715911

- By Bus:** No. 73 – Visit: www.surreycc.gov.uk ...click on: **Bus Timetables** and follow links to service for Chobham
- On Foot:** Starting from Woking Station (Townside) (follow the route -----> shown on the map)
 Approx 1/3 mile – via Station Subway and White Rose Lane.
 Time: About 10 minutes at a moderate pace.
- By Taxi:**
 The Taxi Rank – High Street, Woking, (adjacent to the station)
Calling for taxis from the Hospital:
 For a small charge of 20p, Reception will call for a taxi (usually Woking Taxis, unless a “preferred” service is requested).
- By car (about 4 miles to Woking Town Centre)**
